

Scholarship Award Guidelines

1. The scholarship recipient must be recommended by his State Director of the Knights of Pythagoras to the Supreme council.
2. Only one (1) scholarship application may be submitted from any jurisdiction in any one (1) year.
3. The scholarships will be awarded using the following criteria:
 - a. on the basis of need
 - b. on the basis of scholastic ability
 - c. on the basis of school and community involvement
 - d. must be a graduating high school senior the year the award is made.

The following are criteria of participation that must be met for jurisdictions to recommend students for scholarships.

1. The jurisdiction must contribute a minimum of **\$100.00** specifically for the Scholarship Program each year, there will be no exceptions.
2. Each jurisdiction must have contributed \$100.00 a year at least two years prior to nominating a candidate for a scholarship. *Example* - To make any jurisdiction eligible for the 2008 - 2009 scholarships that are available now, that jurisdiction must pay \$200.00 to cover the prior two years. This is an effort to ensure that those jurisdictions that have not been participating will have an opportunity to participate in 2008 through 2009 just as those jurisdictions that have been participating.
3. Once a jurisdiction has received a scholarship, no other scholarship applicant from that jurisdiction will be eligible for nomination until two years expire. *Example*: If you are awarded a scholarship in 2007, the years 2008 and 2009 must pass before you are eligible again.
4. One thousand dollar scholarships will be awarded to as many applicants as the principle scholarship fund bank interest has generated in one thousand dollar amounts. The scholarship award will be paid to the applicant upon receipt of verification from the Director of Registration and Records of the school, certifying that the applicant is in fact enrolled as a full time student. The Scholarship Award will be presented by the State Director.
